OPEN TO GIRL SCOUTS 14 YEARS AND OLDER
ONE-ON-ONE INSTRUCTION – NO EXPERIENCE NECESSARY
ALL EQUIPMENT PROVIDED
SPACE IS LIMITED – PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED

Who: Girl Scouts 14 and older. Maximum number of Scouts is 28.

Open to Girl Scouts from all Girl Scout Councils.

When: Friday, December 6, 2019 from 6:00-9:00 pm; Check In starts at 5:30 pm.

Where: CRRC (Citizens' Rifle and Revolver Club) in West Windsor.

Route 571, (Princeton-Hightstown Rd) 1/4 mile east of WW Community Park.

What: Shoot .22 pistols and .22 rifles. Learn gun handling and gun safety. All shooting is done indoors and under the close supervision of experienced coaches familiar with CRRC's safety rules and Girl Scout Safety Activity Checkpoints.

All equipment will be provided but you may bring your own eye and ear protection if you like.

If you are not a CRRC member, please do not bring firearms to this event.

Pizza and snacks will be served.

Leaders/Parents: We need 3 adult volunteers to serve food and 4 to chaperone the scouts as per the SAC adult/girl ratio. Adults are welcome to shoot if there is enough time.

Cost: The fee is \$12/girl and \$3/adult.

Registration Form: All participants must be registered Girl Scouts. Scouts may attend as a troop or register individually. Written permission slips are required.
