Certifications

Steps 2-4 each need a certification by a Mentor. Step 5 needs a certification by an Orientation Supervisor.

This Progress Record is for the Candidate's personal use to keep track of their progress. The Candidate should print out his/her Progress Record and make sure that at each Step where a certification is required, the Mentor or Certifier enters their Name, their ID#, their Signature, and the date

All certifications will also be entered electronically by the appropriate Mentor or Certifier as the Candidate meets the requirement for a Step, but the Progress Record can serve as a backup in case of error or omission in the electronic records.

Mentors

Each Mentor must be pre-approved by the Mentor Coordinator as an Approved Pistol Mentor.

The Mentor 1 for a Candidate cannot be the Mentor 2 for the same Candidate.

A Mentor must not be a close friend or relative of the Candidate.

Initial Meeting

Initial Meetings are held only at the CRRC Clubhouse and only by appointment.

Initial Meetings are held at times arranged between a Mentor and a Candidate.

Live Fire Exercises

Live Fire Exercises are held only at the CRRC Clubhouse.

Live Fire Exercises are held at Initial Meetings and Basic Range Orientations. Other times can be arranged between Mentor and Candidate.

Pistols and ammunition will be supplied. Candidates should not bring any pistols or ammunition.

Candidates are encouraged to bring their own eye and ear protection.

When any Candidate shoots on a range, they must be recorded in the Logbook in the Clubhouse as a Guest and have their Range Fee of \$5.00 paid with Cash or Range Stamps. Only one fee per day is required

Fees For Senior Member Candidates

Basic Range Orientation Fee: \$10.00 (payable only online with credit/debit card)

First Reading: Initiation Fee: \$250.00 + NJ Sales Tax (payable only online with credit/debit card)

Second Reading:

Annual Dues \$165.00 + NJ Sales Tax (payable only online with credit/debit card)

Entrance Card Deposit \$20.00 (payable only online with credit/debit card)

Range Stamps Sheet \$10.00 (payable only online with credit/debit card)

The CRRC Fiscal Year runs from June 1 to May 31. When the first annual bill is sent to a new Member, they will only be charged dues for the number of months that they have been in the Club and not \$165 + tax.

Club Members are required to contribute 12 work-hours per Fiscal Year to the Club. In the case of a new Member, this means one work-hour for each full month you have been in the Club during your first year. For every work-hour short of your requirement, you will be billed \$15.00.
